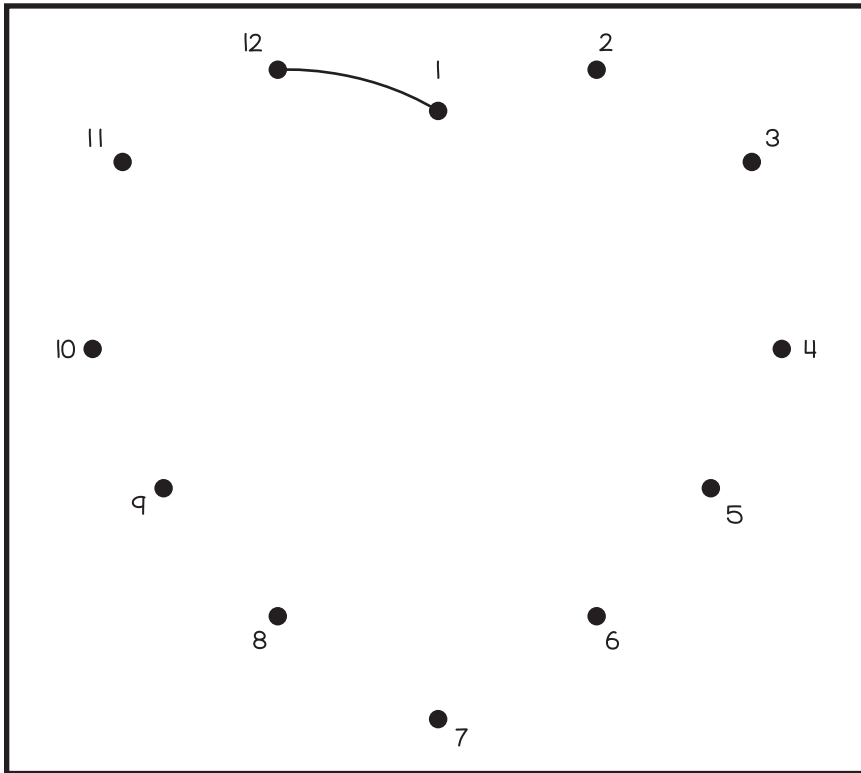


CONNECT^{the}DOTS

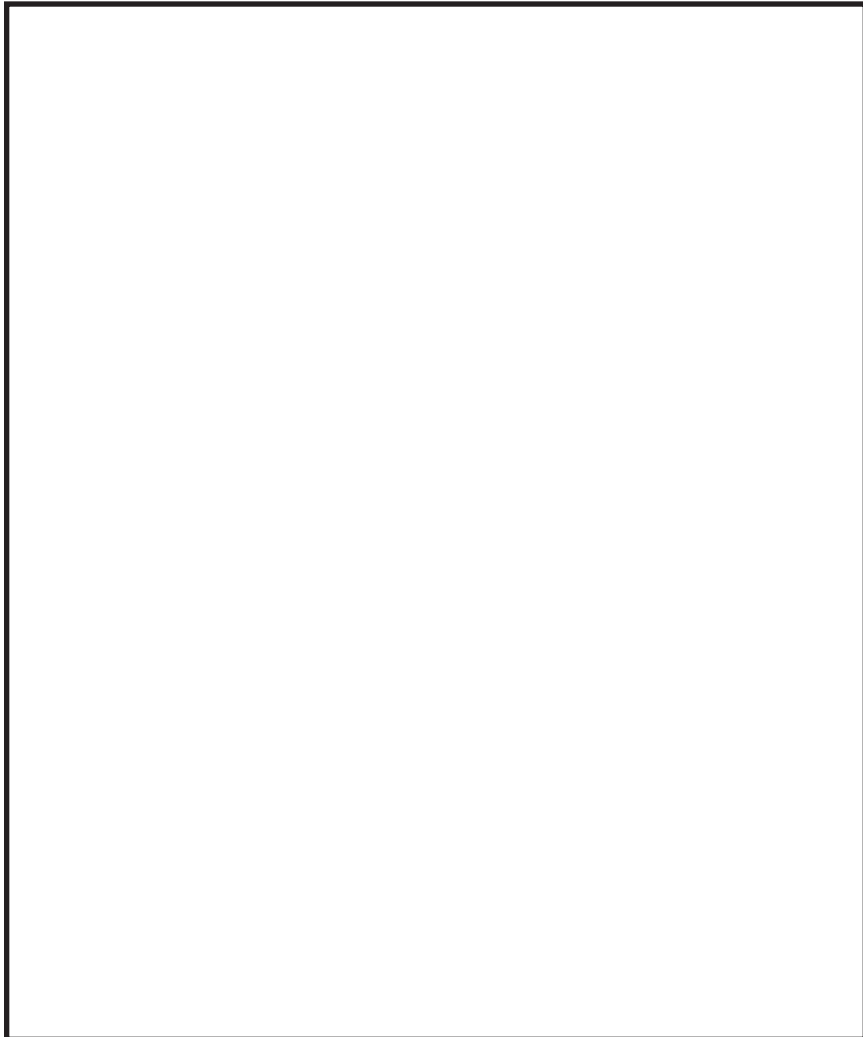
Activities based on Deuteronomy 34:1-12, Psalm 90:1-6, 13-17, Matthew 22:34-46.
