Chapter 2

Christological language of the Christian tradition

We can say: In Jesus, we see more fully than anywhere else what the spirit of God in a person looks like, without saying he's the only way or even the best way

Two primary focal points about the life of Jesus:

a) spirit-filled & b) compassion-filled

A mystic has frequent and vivid experiences of God; knows the sacred Jesus invited his followers into the same relationship with God

Spirituality: becoming conscious of and intentional about a deepening relationship with God

Chapter 3

"What is prayer?"
Jewish Sabbath Prayer:

Days pass and the years vanish,

and we walk sightless among miracles.

Fill our eyes with seeing and our minds with knowing

Let there be moments when Your Presence,

like lightning, illumines the darkness in which we walk.

Help us to see, wherever we gaze,

that the bush burns unconsumed.

And we, clay touched by God,

will reach out for holiness, and exclaim in wonder:

"How filled with awe is this place"

The word for compassion is related to the word for "womb"

"Be compassionate as God is compassionate"

Compassion + justice

Justice is the social dimension of compassion - it has to do with how we structure society

Christian life is about this two-fold relationship:

Our relationship to God and compassion in the world of the everyday.

Paul - 2 Cor 3:18

Speaks of Transformation at the centre of Christian life
